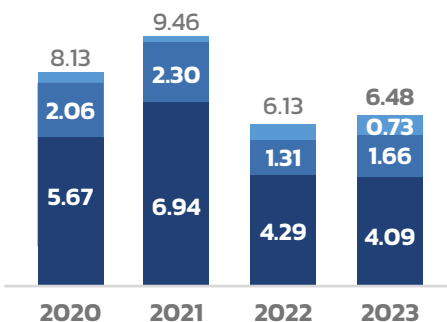

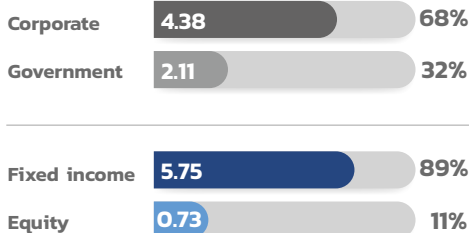
Composition 2023

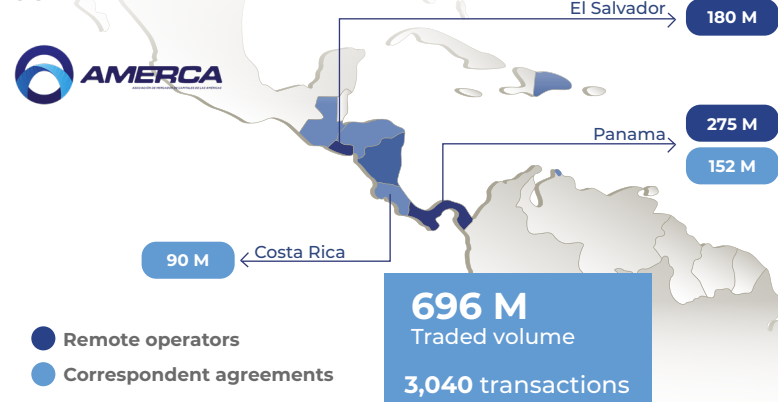

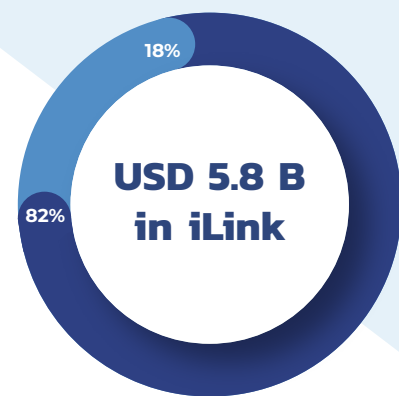

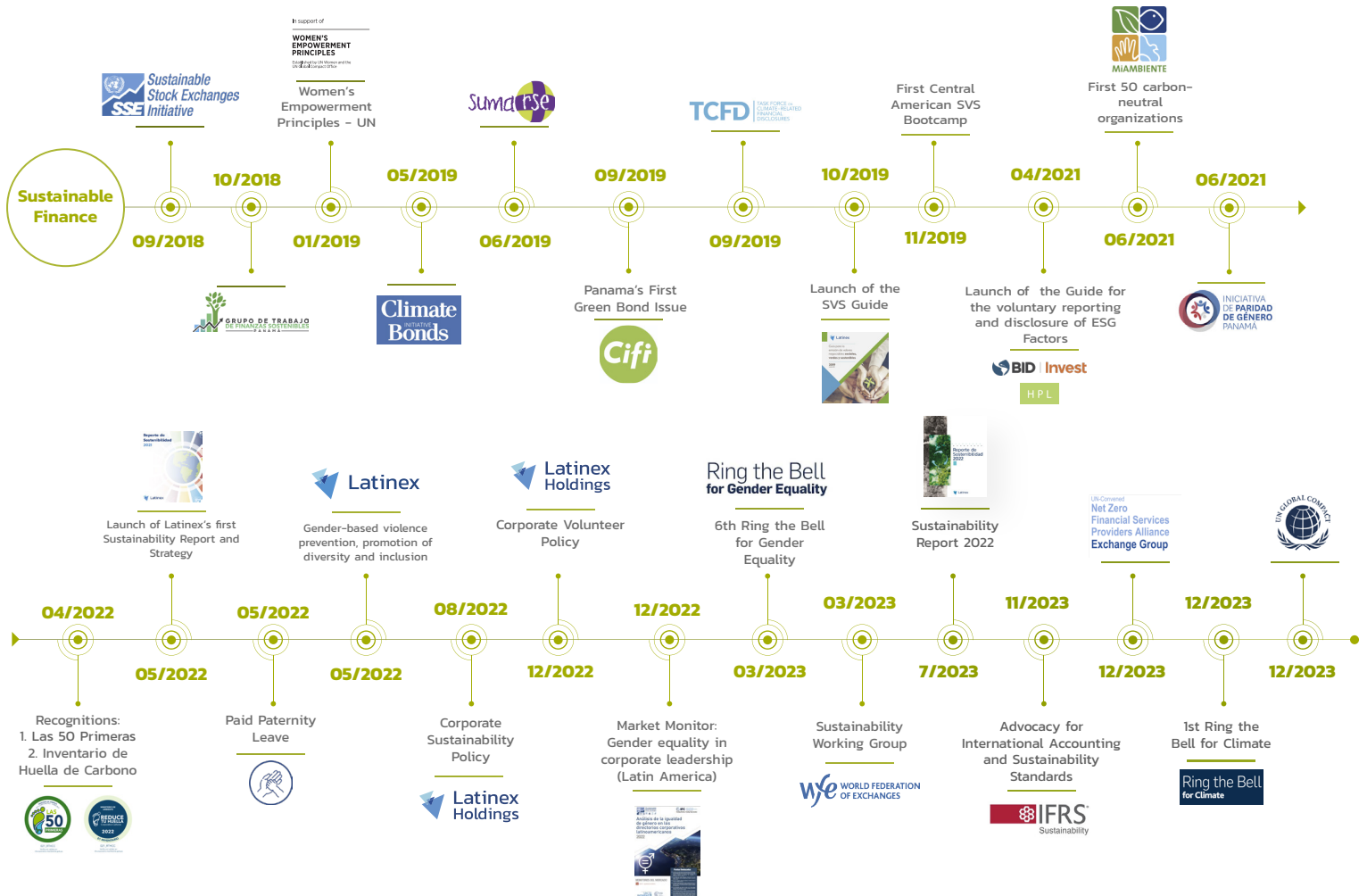
Sustainability
